

CTSO Performance-Based Assessment Conference Scholarship Application

Open to high school seniors graduating in May 2014 and preparing to attend Mat-Su College during the 2014-2015 academic year. Award waives 30 credits of tuition (\$5,040), applicable to Mat-Su College courses only (up to 15 credits each semester for Fall 2014 and Spring 2015).

To be eligible, applicants must:

- 1) Be a high school senior graduating in May 2014 and a member of an Alaska Career & Technical Student Organization (CTSO). These include BPA, DECA, FCCLA, FEA, FFA, HOSA, & Skills USA.
- 2) Have earned a minimum GPA of 2.75 or better in high school
- 4) Be registered or planning to register for classes at Mat-Su College for the fall 2014 semester
