We provide a challenging curriculum tailored to teach students to provide oral health and preventive services in Alaska. Students accepted to our program are required to obtain Tribal Health Organization sponsorship. Tribal sponsorship guarantees employment upon successful completion of the 2 year program. Thanks to THO Sponsorship and additional funding from ANTHC, Rasmuson Foundation, and the W.K. Kellogg Foundation the benefits of being a student include: no tuition costs, monthly living stipends and assistance with transportation costs to/from home community. ANTHC will provide assistance in finding Tribal Health Organization Sponsorship.

Minimum Requirements:

- High school Diploma or GED
- DHSS Background and criminal background check clearance
- Drug free (mandatory drug testing is part of our admissions process)
