Eligibility Requirement

To be eligible to enter the AOGA Scholarship Essay Contest, entrants must:

- Be a U.S. citizen and permanent resident of the state of Alaska;
- Be a junior (grade 11) or senior (grade 12) at an Alaska school or home school ;
- Provide Student Information outlined above; and,
- Provide an original essay addressing the selected topic with references properly cited.

Selection Process

Entries must be received by April 25, 2016.

The essays will be reviewed by a committee comprised of experts in resource development policy, education, and the oil and gas industry. Essays will be judged on concept development, evidential support, grammar, style, and originality.
