- Step 1. Apply for admission at uas.alaska.edu/apply.
- **Step 2.** Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at **faf-sa.ed.gov**. The UAS school code is **001065**.
- **Step 3.** Set up your student ID and password at **elmo.uas.alaska.edu.**
- **Step 4.** Navigate to **alaska.academicworks.com**, and click the "Sign In" button on the top right of the screen using your student ID and password. Complete the General Application and the UA Southeast campus application.
- **Step 5.** On the "Opportunities" tab, complete any other recommended scholarships.

ALASKA LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE

Application review begins **February 15**

Open to first-time UAS students who plan to live on-campus and are accepted into the UAS leadership program. **\$2,000** for on-campus housing costs. Application requires a one-page essay.

VERNA CARRIGAN PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

Application deadline: February 15

Available to Southeast Alaska high school seniors who show promise as incoming UAS students but have had to overcome challenges and/or hardships in their high school careers. Eligible recipients will be current seniors from Juneau Douglas High School, Thunder Mountain High School, Yaakoosge Daakahidi High School, Mt Edgecumbe High School, or graduating seniors from another Southeast Alaska high school, including home school programs. One scholarship is available at each school. Up to five students will each receive a one-time \$3,000 award.

Submit the general scholarship application available through alaska.academicworks.com and submit two letters of recommendation from high school staff and/or a community leader to the UAS Financial Aid Office.

UAS CHANCELLOR'S AWARD

Application review begins February 15

Open to first-year UA Scholars OR Alaska Performance Scholarship recipients OR students with a high school GPA of 3.5 & 1210 SAT or 25 ACT. **\$2,600** for on-campus housing costs your first academic year and up to **\$1,300** for on-campus housing costs your second academic year.

UA SCHOLARS AWARD

Apply for admission by May 1

Awarded to the top 10% of each graduating high school class in Alaska. **\$12,000** over the course of 8 semesters in a 5 year period.

ALASKA PERFORMANCE SCHOLARSHIP

File FAFSA by **June 30**

Open to students who meet the requirements set forth by the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education. Awards range from **\$2,378/year** to **\$4,755/year**, based on high school performance.
